Once I graduated from high school in 2013, I was enrolled in a Short Course, Computer Literacy Program, where I got to learn some basic computer skills that I still use to date. Through the help of CHC, I got an internship at JBG. H.

P. Gauff Ingenieure GmbH & Co. which further improved my computer and working skills since they noticed that this specific field was my passion.

For my long course, I was enrolled in Jomo Kenyatta University of Agriculture and Technology (JKUAT) to pursue a Diploma in Information Technology in which I graduated in 2016. I was fortunate that you accepted my request to further my studies to a degree course in the same field which I completed in April 2019.

Apart from education, it is really important to gain self-development skills.

Programmes such as QX (a series of workshops) and Angaza coaching (Kenyan based) provided me with skills and tools that I needed to understand my strengths, to learn how to work in diverse groups, and the preparation needed to fit into the job market. I got a job at a local company here in Kenya where am still working to date.

The greatest lesson under CHC is "If you ever have an opportunity to just hold somebody's hand, do it. Kindness is never something you need to look back on with regret".
