Due to the container ship blocking the Suez Canal earlier this year, affecting shipping traffic worldwide, our cargo was considerably delayed and did not arrive in Mombasa until mid-July. Customs clearance, onforwarding, and completion work on the plant in Nairobi led to further postponements. Meanwhile, however, the desalination plant is on site and is now being installed and tested. A small inauguration ceremony for CHC's most expensive project to date, is planned for 22 September.

The planning team was very satisfied with the event. Unfortunately, due to Corona, the event was not live, but only virtual. However, the virtual format – first set up last year as a stopgap solution - was again very well received and resulted in a lot of positive feedback.

The Bubisa water project as this year's good cause, also acted as a special motivator. So, although participants (mostly) ran or cycled alone, they all contributed to a great common success: we will probably

be able to account more than 100,000 euros in revenue. The CNW Courier Network forwarding company, in particular, contributed to this record result with an exceptionally high donation...

Dorothea von Boxberg, Chairman of the Executive Board of Lufthansa Cargo, also participated and once again confirmed Lufthansa Cargo's continued support of CHC. The planning team now hopes that the hybrid model will work for the first time at the end of August 2022: in Frankfurt as well as virtually and globally, since the many participants have proven that there are generous and committed CHC supporters all over our planet!
