

Cargo Human Care projects

Mothers' Mercy Home (MMH):

MMH is a home for 120 orphans in Nairobi-Kianjogu. The children are cared for by a team of social workers and 'mothers'. Our vision is to provide children, adolescents, and young adults with the basis for an independent and self-determined life. Our mission: we support the MMH in all matters. We take care of nutrition, hygiene, and medical care, as well as clothing and playground equipment - and the financing of future-oriented schooling and vocational training.

The John Kaheni Residence (JKR):

In the spirit of sustainable help for young people in Kenya, Cargo Human Care does everything possible to provide them with good prospects and the best possible start to an independent and self-reliant life, even after they have finished school. In the John Kaheni Residence, the focus is on vocational training. Numerous JKR support programmes prepare young people for professional life. A training workshop for leather processing and tailoring is connected to the JKR.

Cargo Human Care Medical Centre:

The Medical Centre was opened in 2009 and is attached to the 'Mothers' Mercy Home' building. In the well-equipped outpatient clinic, local employees care for 12,000 patients who would otherwise be unable to afford medical care. More than 35,000 treatments are carried out each year. German medical specialists regularly support the team on site on a voluntary basis during brief missions.

Happy Child Education Centre:

In 2019, the school built in cooperation with the Lufthansa aid organization, Help Alliance, and the Regine Sixt Children's Aid Foundation, was opened in the slum area of Kabiria/Nairobi, on the grounds of the Anglican Church. It offers space for 200 children from the immediate vicinity, who previously had no access to educational institutions.

Wings Academy:

In autumn 2011, northern Kenya was hit by a devastating famine. In cooperation with the Anglican Bishop of the Diocese of Marsabit, a concept was developed to feed 224 families in the two villages of Karare and Komboi.

From the surplus of the collected donations, we initially built two classrooms in 2012, and thus provided children with access to school education for the first time. The school was named 'Wings Academy' and was expanded over the years into a primary school for eight grades, with accommodation for 40 girls and 40 boys. 250 children currently (2023) attend this school. In 2023, a secondary school for girls was added. School sponsorships support all girls and boys at the secondary schools.

Water for Bubisa:

In the summer of 2020, we received a call for help from the community of Bubisa in Marsabit. The water supply for the approx. 8,000 inhabitants and more than 100,000 animals, had collapsed. We decided to drill for water. At a depth of 320 metres, we came across a very large water reservoir and, in cooperation with Caritas International, financed the construction of a desalination plant which was put into operation at the end of 2021. Since then, the plant has been providing pure drinking water.

Cargo Human Care e. V. (CHC) is a humanitarian and medical aid project that was founded in 2007 by Lufthansa Cargo employees in cooperation with doctors from all over Germany. The association focuses on providing direct medical assistance to impoverished, sick, and suffering people, and giving destitute and disadvantaged orphans a home and a future. Working together with local institutions, Cargo Human Care e.V. delivers practical help directly to where it is needed. Lufthansa Cargo has generously supported the project from the very beginning.

"I noticed that, with relatively little effort, I could make a lot of difference in Kenya, and that people are willing to support tangible projects in Africa. When it came to financing a heart operation for little John Kaheni from the Mothers' Mercy Home in 2004, sponsors were found in no time at all. And that is still my motivation today. How can I help?

You can support us by becoming a Cargo Human Care e.V. member, paying regular monthly or annual contributions, or with single donations. We also offer sponsorships for school and vocational training to support children and young people.

School sponsorships

It is very important to us that our children receive a good school education. For around 40 to 50 euros a month, children can attend the fee-paying, private primary and secondary schools, and thus lay the foundation for their future. The school sponsorship runs until the end of the child's school education at the age of about 18, after which the young person can switch to a training sponsorship.

Training sponsorships / JKR programme

Three local social workers look after about 70 young people during vocational training in our 'John Kaheni Residence'. The costs currently amount to 280 euros per month, which can also be covered by partial sponsorships.

Medical sponsorships

More than 60 children and young people outside our own homes are cared for through this programme. Some of them have a serious medical problem and require specific medical support - others come from catastrophic social circumstances. The sponsorship enables them to attend school for the first time and thus gain access to education and (very important) one warm meal a day. A small team from Germany, together with a local social worker, takes great care of these children

and young people. The costs depend on individual needs (40 to 120 euros per month).
