Elazar Girls High School inauguration ceremony

Dear members and friends of Cargo Human Care,

It's not just Germany that has seen above-average rainfall this year; large parts of Kenya and the whole of East Africa have also been flooded in recent weeks. Even the normally extremely dry region around our Wings Academy and the Bubisa well project in northern Kenya, is currently a lush green colour. Just a few months ago, it was so dry there that 90% of the livestock had to starve. Since 2011, we have repeatedly been delivering food to several villages to spare people from this fate.

Many of you have asked whether our projects were affected by the floods. No, nobody was harmed in our two homes in Nairobi. The Medical Centre and the Garden of Siloam, which we support, also remained unscathed. Many of the families' huts around our Happy Child School were under water, but the school itself was spared. Also here, nobody came to any harm.

The Elazar Girls High School in Marsabit, which was officially opened at the beginning of May, was the project that was largely financed by the 2023 Office City Run. The run will now take place for the tenth time, on 29 August 2024. Once again, it will be a hybrid race, live in Frankfurt and virtual elsewhere in the world. We have decided to finance a larger vocational training centre with the run's proceeds this year. Planning has begun and we will soon be reporting on it. Although 53 girls have already been attending the new Senior Secondary School right next to our Wings Academy since January 2024, for organisational reasons, its official inauguration did not take place until 4 May. In addition to representatives of government organisations, Bishop Qampicha and many church representatives, Elazar Grinstein and Kenneth Allan, the CEO of his logistics company, CNW, also attended the impressive ceremony. Grinstein has generously supported CHC's projects for years and had travelled all the way from the USA for the occasion. CHC was represented by Dr Thomas Berger and Gerhard Meyke.

Over 300 pupils and a large number of parents participated in the ceremony with

lively singing and dancing. The unveiling of commemorative plaques bearing the names of very generous donors, on the different buildings, took place towards the end of the ceremony to great applause from all those present.

This school is the only institution in Marsabit County (which is roughly the size of the UK) that combines all school types under one roof: pre-school, primary, junior secondary and senior secondary school
