SPONSORSHIP OVERVIEW

School partnership

40 to 50 euros a month enables children in Nairobi or Marsabit to attend private primary and secondary schools. In this way, we lay the foundations for their future. After finishing school, they move on to vocational training, for example at the John Kaheni Residence (JKR).

Vocational Training Sponsorship / JKR Program

Our local social workers provide intensive support to over 70 young people during their vocational training. Including accommodation, the costs currently amount to 280 euros per month. Partial sponsorships are also possible.

Medical Sponsorships

We support more than 60 children and young people who do not live in our facilities. Some are in urgent need of medical care, whilst others live in extremely difficult conditions. Through sponsorships, they gain access to treatment, education and regular meals for the first time.

CARGO HUMAN CARE OUR PROJECTS IN FOCUS

Mothers’ Mercy Home (MMH)

The MMH is a home for up to 120 orphans in Nairobi-Kianjogu. A team of social workers and ‘Mothers’ look after the children and young people.

Our vision: to give young people the foundations for an independent life.

We provide comprehensive support to the home – from food and medical care to schooling and personal development.

Cargo Human Care Medical Centre

Our Medical Centre opened in 2009. Here, around 13,000 patients receive medical care that they would otherwise be unable to afford. In total, we carry out over 40,000 treatments per year. A strong Kenyan team and the involvement of German specialists ensure high-quality care – and give many people new hope. For as little as 21 euros a year, you can help one person gain access to comprehensive medical care, medication and surgery. (include average costs for 2025)

John Kaheni Residence (JKR)

After they finish school, we support young people on their journey towards an independent life. At the JKR, the focus is on vocational training. Over 70 young adults are looked after here by our local team and specifically prepared for working life.

The program is complemented by our training workshop for tailoring and leatherwork, where they learn practical skills.

Our aim: to actively shape the transition from school to work – and thereby create real opportunities.

Vocational Training Centre (VTC) Training workshop

With over ten years’ experience at JKR, we know just how crucial good vocational training is. At the same time, for many young people in Kenya, it is barely accessible, too expensive or of insufficient quality. That is why, from 2026, we will be building our own vocational training centre and consistently developing our concept further.

Wings Academy

We first arrived in Marsabit in northern Kenya in 2011, in the wake of a famine.

A food aid program gave rise to a school: the Wings Academy. Today, it is a primary and junior secondary school with nine year groups. Over 400 children attend the school, and around 80 of them also live on site.

Happy Child Education Centre

The Happy Child Education Centre in Kabiria (Nairobi) was built and opened in 2019.

Around 150 children from the slum area are given access to education here. The school is run by the Anglican parish. We provide regular financial support, are represented on the school board, and also support the children as they progress to secondary schools.

Elazar Girls’ High School

Girls from the region have been attending this secondary school since 2024.

For them, education means far more than just lessons: it protects them from forced marriage and opens up the chance of a self-determined life.

We continue to support the graduates even after they leave
